Many men and women are honored along the Walk of Pavers just North of the Legion at the entrance to the parking lot.

There is still room to pay gratitude to more of our patriots.

Pavers are available in two sizes: 4" X 8" will cost \$60 and 8" X 8" will cost \$120. Laser imprinting will allow from one to three lines with 15-18 character for the smaller and 6 lines for the larger.



Laser implanted military branch symbols may also be included for an extra \$10, however it will reduce the number of characters available in each line.

An identical miniature paver 1 ½" X 3" is also available with the veterans information inscribed for an additional \$20.
