## American Flag Presentation to Post 24

American Legion Post 24 was honored to receive a United States flag presented by Captain Andrew Shaughnessy.

Captain Shaughnessy was deployed to Iraq in support of **Operation**



**Inherent Resolve (OIR)**, serving as the Fire Support Officer / Joint Terminal Attack Controller (FSO/JTAC) for Special Operations Task Force–Levant. Special Operations Task Force–Levant operates out of Camp Holleyman at Erbil Airbase in Iraq. During the deployment, their unit

maintained a flag pole and routinely flew American flags over their location. This particular flag was flown on Christmas Day and was dedicated specifically to Post 24.

Captain Shaughnessy grew up in McPherson, and his parents, Michael and Edith Shaughnessy, continue to reside here. This makes the presentation especially meaningful, as it represents not only service to our nation but a direct connection to our local community.

In a powerful and fitting connection, Captain Shaughnessy’s home station is the **1st Battalion, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne)**, whose unit nickname is “Legion.” It is especially symbolic that a flag flown in a combat zone by a unit known as “Legion” now rests with our American Legion Post 24.

American Legion Post 24 extends its sincere gratitude to Captain Shaughnessy for this thoughtful and meaningful gift. We are deeply honored that he chose our Post to receive a flag flown in a combat zone, and we thank him for his service, his sacrifice, and his continued connection to his hometown and fellow veterans.



## HB 2214 Alert: Call Your Senator Today

Bob Cox from the VFW asked Kathy Nicholson to urge Legion members to contact Senator Michael Fagg and urge him to vote NO on Kansas House Bill 2214. The bill primarily seeks to regulate for-profit services that assist veterans in claiming benefits. Opponents argue the bill might authorize for-profit services that conflict with federal law, potentially reducing existing consumer protections for veterans.

During the House Veterans and Military Committee hearing on Feb 3, debate focused on whether Kansas HB2214 would safeguard veterans or inadvertently permit predatory practices by for-profit companies. Arguments for the bill centered on veteran choice, addressing service gaps left by traditional Veterans Service Organizations, and implementing consumer protections. Opponents raised concerns about "claim sharks," conflict with federal law, erosion of veteran rights, and security issues with for-profit companies’ access to private information. The Kansas House passed the bill, so it moves to the Senate. Please contact Senator Fagg at **785-296-7678**.

Richard Johnson, our Post’s Service Officer, noted that he has spoken with veterans who have had for-profit companies charge 30% of the initial back pay sum, and then charge 10% for every monthly payment for life. This is a high price to pay for benefits you’ve earned through service and can get for free.
